

Foreign Tourist Inflow to India July 2019

Ministry of Tourism compiles monthly Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs) & FTAs on e- Tourist Visa on the basis of information received from Bureau of Immigration (BOI). The following are the important highlights regarding FTAs and FTAs on e-Tourist Visa during the month of July, 2019:

Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs):

- FTAs in July 2019 were 8,17,455 as compared to 8,06,495 in July 2018 registering a growth of 1.4%.
- FTAs during the period January-July 2019 were 60,84,353 as compared to 59,57,816 in January- July 2018 registering a growth of 2.1%.
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during July, 2019 among the top 15 source countries was highest from Bangladesh (23.67%) followed by USA (16.02%), UK (10.12%), Malaysia (3.15%), China (2.78%), Sri Lanka (2.75%), France (2.71%), Canada (2.29%), Australia (2.22%), Japan (2.15%), Germany (2.05%), Singapore (1.68%), Nepal (1.63%), Rep. of Korea (1.52%),and UAE (1.35%).
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during July, 2019 among the top 15 ports was highest at Delhi Airport (25.47%) followed by Mumbai Airport (13.22%), Haridaspur Land Check Post (10.59%), Chennai Airport (10.05%), Bengaluru Airport (7.67%), Kolkata Airport (4.93%), Hyderabad Airport (4.74%), Cochin Airport (4.39%), Gede Rail Land Check Post (2.67%), Ahmedabad Airport (2.15%), Ghojadanga Land Check Post (2.12%), Tiruchirappalli Airport (1.52%), Trivandrum Airport (1.38%), Agartala Land Check Post (1.21%) and Chitpur Rail Land Check Post (0.84%).

FTAs on e-Tourist Visa:

- During the month of July, 2019 total of 1,77,084 tourist arrived on e-Tourist Visa as compared to 1,58,337 during the month of July, 2018 registering a growth of 11.8%.
- During January- July 2019, a total of 15,34,293 tourist arrived on e-Tourist Visa as compared to 12,68,077 during January-July 2018, registering a growth of 21.0%.
- The percentage shares of top 15 source countries availing e-Tourist Visa facilities during July, 2019 were highest from USA (12.2%), followed by UK (10.9%), China (8.3%), France (5.9%), Malaysia (5.9%), UAE (5.0%), Oman (3.6%), Spain (3.2%), Germany (3.0%), Australia (2.8%), Canada (2.7%), Singapore (2.3%), Israel (2.3%), Italy (2.3%) and Japan (2.0%).
- The percentage shares of top 15 ports in tourist arrivals on e-Tourist Visa during July, 2019 were highest from New Delhi Airport (38.5%) followed by Mumbai Airport (17.4%), Chennai Airport (10.8%), Bengaluru Airport (10.4%), Hyderabad Airport (5.3%), Kochi Airport (4.9%), Tirchy Airport (2.9%), Kolkata Airport (2.4%), Ahmedabad Airport (1.6%), Trivandrum Airport (1.1%), Calicut Airport (1.1%), Amritsar Airport (1.0%), Jaipur Airport (0.5%), Dabolim (Goa) Airport (0.4%), Coimbatore Airport (0.3%) and Sonauli Land Checkpost (0.3%).
