
Foreign Tourist Inflow to India during 2022

Ministry of Tourism compiles monthly Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs) on the basis of information received from Bureau of Immigration (BOI). The following are the important highlights regarding FTAs during the month of December, 2022.

Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs):

- FTAs in December, 2022 were 9,66,270 as compared to 3,17,647 in December, 2021 and 12,26,398 in December, 2019 registering a growth of 204.2% and -21.2% with respect to 2021 and 2019 respectively.
- FTAs during the period January- December, 2022 were 61,91,399 as compared to 15,27,114 in January-December, 2021 and 1,09,30,355 in January-December, 2019 registering a growth of 305.4% and -43.4% with respect to 2021 and 2019 respectively.
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during December, 2022 among the top 15 source countries was highest from USA (22.71%) followed by Bangladesh (19.36%), Australia (9.74%), UK (9.14%), Canada (4.24%), Russian Fed. (2.49,%), Malaysia (2.17%), Singapore (2.06%), Sri Lanka (1.89%), Germany (1.82%), Nepal (1.55%), France (1.37%), New Zealand (1.34%) Italy (1.24%), and Maldives (1.07%).
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during January- December, 2022 among the top 15 source countries was highest from USA (22.19%), followed by Bangladesh (20.29%), UK (9.98%), Australia (5.96%), Canada (4.48%), Sri Lanka (2.87%), Nepal (2.19%), Germany (2.01%), Singapore (1.89%), Malaysia (1.88%), France (1.79%), Russian Federation (1.54%), Maldives (1.14%), Portugal (1.10%), & Italy (0.97%).
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during December 2022 among the top 15 ports was highest at Delhi Airport (28.12%) followed by Mumbai Airport (17.74%), Haridaspur Land Check Post (9.07%), Chennai Airport (7.81%), Bengaluru Airport (6.32%), Hyderabad Airport (4.29%), Cochin Airport (4.20%), Kolkata Airport (3.64%), Ahmedabad Airport (3.25%), Dabolim (Goa) Airport (2.44%), Ghojadanga Land Check Post (1.83%), Changrabandha Land Check Post (1.23%), Tiruchirappalli Airport (1.18%), Chitpur Rail Check Post (1.15%) and Trivandrum Airport (1.13%),
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during January-December 2022 among the top 15 ports was highest at Delhi Airport (31.21%) followed by Mumbai Airport (14.70%), Haridaspur Land Check Post (9.47%), Chennai Airport (9.24%), Bengaluru Airport (6.36%), Hyderabad Airport (4.69%), Cochin Airport

(4.39%), Kolkata Airport (3.85%), Ahmedabad Airport (2.78%), Ghojadanga Land Check Post (1.60%), Agartala Land Check Post (1.33%), Trivandrum Airport (1.32%), Dabolim (Goa) Airport (1.30%), Tiruchirappalli Airport (1.07%) and Changrabandha Land Check Post (1.05%).
