

**Foreign Exchange Earnings (in rupee and US \$ terms) through tourism
in India in November 2018**

Based on the credit data of Travel Head from Balance of Payments of RBI for the previous year, Ministry of Tourism estimates monthly Foreign Exchange Earnings (FEEs) through tourism in India, both in rupee and dollar terms.

The highlights of the estimates of FEEs from tourism in India for November 2018 are as below:

Foreign Exchange Earnings (FEEs) through tourism (in Rs. terms)

- FEEs during the month of November 2018 were Rs. 16,577 crore as compared to Rs. 16,528 crore in November 2017.
- FEEs during the period January- November 2018 were Rs. 1,75,423 crore with a growth of 10.7%, in FEE over Rs. 1,58,493 crore in January- November 2017.

Foreign Exchange Earnings (FEEs) through tourism (in US \$ terms)

- FEEs in US\$ terms during the month of November 2018 were US\$ 2.301 billion as compared to FEEs of US\$ 2.549 billion during the month of November 2017.
- FEEs during the period January- November 2018 were US\$ 25.838 billion with a growth of 6.4% in FEE over US\$ 24.292 billion in January- November 2017.
