

Foreign Exchange Earnings (in rupee and US \$ terms) through tourism in India in June 2018

Based on the credit data of Travel Head from Balance of Payments of RBI for the previous year, Ministry of Tourism estimates monthly Foreign Exchange Earnings (FEEs) through tourism in India, both in rupee and dollar terms.

The highlights of the estimates of FEEs from tourism in India for June 2018 are as below:

Foreign Exchange Earnings (FEEs) through tourism (in Rs. terms)

- FEEs during the month of June 2018 were Rs. 14,342 crore as compared to Rs. 12,971 crore in June 2017.
- The growth rate in FEEs in rupee terms in June 2018 over June 2017 was 10.6%.
- FEEs during the period January- June 2018 were Rs. 95,713 crore with a growth of 12.2%, in FEE over Rs. 85,305 crore in January-June 2017.

Foreign Exchange Earnings (FEEs) through tourism (in US \$ terms)

- FEEs in US\$ terms during the month of June 2018 were US\$ 2.116 billion as compared to FEEs of US\$ 2.013 billion during the month of June 2017.
- The growth rate in FEEs in US\$ terms in June 2018 over June 2017 was 5.1%.
- FEEs during the period January-June 2018 were US\$ 14.625 billion with a growth of 12.9% in FEE over US\$ 12.958 billion in January-Junes 2017.
