#### Message

I take this opportunity to exhort all stakeholders in the tourism and travel industry to strive together in making India one of the most preferred destinations in the world.






#### Best Civic Management of a Tourist Destination in India, Category 'B'

#### Best Maintained and Disabled Friendly Monument

**Bhojpur Temple** Bhojpur, Madhya Pradesh



The 11th century Bhojpur temple stands magnificently over the outcrop rock lying on the right bank of the river Betwa (ancient Vetrawati). This unique temple, incomplete for some unknown reasons is ascribed to the illustrious King Bhojadeva (1010-1055 A.D.) of Paramara dynasty of Central India, who was a great patron of art, architecture and learning. It is about 32 kms southeast of Bhopal and has been made disabled-friendly monument by Archaeological Survey of India (ASI), which has laid beautiful pathways at the site. The wooden staircases with the ramp has been made accessible to differently abled visitors. The differently abled visitors are provided wheelchairs so that they can go up to the Shiva Temple to have a glimpse of the monument.

Bhopal Habibganj Railway Station is located in Bhopal City and it is part of the West Central Railway. Trains to all the major destinations are easily available from here. #### Swami Vivekananda Airport Raipur, Chhattisgarh



### India City Walks for Mehrauli Archaeological Park, Delhi




