**RURAL CIRCUIT UNDER THE SWADESH DARSHAN SCHEME**

1892. SARDAR BALWINDER SINGH BHUNDER:

Will the Minister of **TOURISM** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there have been any proposals submitted by States for identifying specific regions for rural circuit under the Swadesh Darshan Scheme;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise, with a particular reference to Punjab; and
- (c) the details of projects sanctioned under the rural circuit of the Swadesh Darshan Scheme?

(a) to (c): The projects for development under Swadesh Darshan Scheme are identified in consultation with the State Governments /UT Administrations /Central Agencies and are sanctioned subject to submission of project proposals, their adherence to relevant scheme guidelines, submission of suitable detailed project reports, availability of funds, and utilization of funds released earlier. Submission of proposals by the State Governments and its sanctioning under the Scheme is a continuous process.

Based on the above criteria, the details of projects sanctioned under Rural Circuit are as follows:
