IMPLEMENTATION OF PRASAD SCHEME IN KARNATAKA

10. SHRI B.Y. RAGHAVENDRA:

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any plan to implement PRASAD scheme in Shimogga District by considering its old history;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) if not, the time by which the historic temples like Marikamba and others will be considered;
- (d) whether the Government has any plan to implement PRASAD scheme in any part of Karnataka State; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR TOURISM (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) (SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)

(a) to (e): Development of Pilgrimage Centres/Tourist centres is the responsibility of respective State Governments/Union Territories. "Pilgrimage Ministry of Tourism, under the schemes viz. Reiuvenation and Spiritual. Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD)" provides Central Financial Assistance for infrastructure development and beautification of pilgrim places on receipt of State suitable proposals submitted by **Governments/Union** Territories, subject to availability of funds, liquidation of pending utilisation certificate against the fund released earlier and adherence to the relevant scheme guidelines.

Based on the proposal received from the State Government of Karnataka Ministry of Tourism identified "Chamundeshwari Devi Temple, District Mysuru" for pilgrimage infrastructure development under the scheme. Concept Presentation for the project was held on 18.09.2019. However, during the site visit conducted by the team from the Ministry of Tourism to access the requirement of the developments, it was observed that a project for creation of infrastructure facilities covering almost all the required for pilgrimage, is being implemented at Chamundeshwari Devi temple by the state Government of Karnataka. Thus at present no proposal from the state Government of Karnataka is under consideration under PRASHAD Scheme of Ministry of Tourism.
