RURAL TOURISM CLUSTERS AND PARKS IN MAHARASHTRA

3425. SHRI HEMANT TUKARAM GODSE:

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is a proposal to build rural tourism clusters and tourism parks to promote tourism at a large scale in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise; and
- (c) the details and the number of such clusters and parks proposed to be set up in Maharashtra?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR TOURISM (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) (SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)

(a) to (c): Ministry of Tourism under the Swadesh Darshan Scheme is developing tourism infrastructure in identified circuits including Tourist Parks and Tourism Clusters across the country having tourism potential in a planned and prioritized manner. Rural circuit has been identified as one of the thematic circuit for development under the scheme.

The projects under the scheme are identified for development in consultation with the State Governments/Union Territory Administrations and are sanctioned subject to availability of funds, submission of suitable Detailed Project Reports, adherence to scheme guidelines and utilization of funds released earlier. Based on the above criteria, the details of projects sanctioned under Rural Circuit and in Maharashtra are as follows:
