

## **Foreign Exchange Earnings (in rupee and US \$ terms) through tourism in India in July, 2019**

Based on the credit data of Travel Head from Balance of Payments of RBI for the previous year, Ministry of Tourism estimates monthly Foreign Exchange Earnings (FEEs) through tourism in India, both in rupee and dollar terms.

The highlights of the estimates of FEEs from tourism in India for July 2019 are as below:

### **Foreign Exchange Earnings (FEEs) from Tourism in Rs. Terms**

- FEEs during the month of July 2019 were Rs. 18,191 crore as compared to Rs. 16,976 crore in July 2018.
- The growth rate in FEEs in rupee terms in July 2019 over July 2018 was 7.2%.
- FEEs during the period January- July 2019 were Rs. 1,16,872 crore as compared to Rs. 1,12,481 crore in January- July 2018.
- The growth rate in FEEs in rupee terms in January- July 2019 over January- July 2018 was 3.9%.

### **Foreign Exchange Earnings (FEEs) from Tourism in US\$ terms**

- FEEs in US\$ terms during the month of July 2019 were US\$ 2.644 billion as compared to FEEs of US\$ 2.468 billion during the month of July 2018.
- The growth rate in FEEs in US\$ terms in July 2019 over July 2018 was 7.1%.
- FEE during the period January- July 2019 were US \$ 16.757 billion as compared to US \$ 17.059 billion in January- July 2018.
- The growth rate in FEE in US\$ billion in January- July 2019 over January- July 2018 was -1.8%.
