

Foreign Exchange Earnings (in rupee and US \$ terms) through tourism in India in June, 2019

Based on the credit data of Travel Head from Balance of Payments of RBI for the previous year, Ministry of Tourism estimates monthly Foreign Exchange Earnings (FEEs) through tourism in India, both in rupee and dollar terms.

The highlights of the estimates of FEEs from tourism in India for June 2019 are as below:

Foreign Exchange Earnings (FEEs) from Tourism in Rs. Terms

- FEEs during the month of June 2019 were Rs. 15,963 crore as compared to Rs. 14,398 crore in June 2018.
- The growth rate in FEEs in rupee terms in June 2019 over June 2018 was 10.9%.
- FEEs during the period January- June 2019 were Rs. 98,681 crore as compared to Rs. 95,505 crore in January- June 2018.
- The growth rate in FEEs in rupee terms in January- June 2019 over January- June 2018 was 3.3%.

Foreign Exchange Earnings (FEEs) from Tourism in US\$ terms

- FEEs in US\$ terms during the month of June 2019 were US\$ 2.299 billion as compared to FEEs of US\$ 2.124 billion during the month of June 2018.
- The growth rate in FEEs in US\$ terms in June 2019 over June 2018 was 8.2%.
- FEE during the period January- June 2019 were US \$ 14.113 billion as compared to US \$ 14.591 billion in January- June 2018.
- The growth rate in FEE in US\$ billion in January- June 2019 over January- June 2018 was -3.3%.
