

Foreign Exchange Earnings (in rupee and US \$ terms) through tourism in India in May, 2019

Based on the credit data of Travel Head from Balance of Payments of RBI for the previous year, Ministry of Tourism estimates monthly Foreign Exchange Earnings (FEEs) through tourism in India, both in rupee and dollar terms.

The highlights of the estimates of FEEs from tourism in India for May 2019 are as below:

Foreign Exchange Earnings (FEEs) from Tourism in Rs. Terms

- FEEs during the month of May 2019 were Rs. 13,541 crore as compared to Rs. 12,753 crore in May 2018.
- The growth rate in FEEs in rupee terms in May 2019 over May 2018 was 6.2%.
- FEEs during the period January- May 2019 were Rs. 82,718 crore as compared to Rs. 81,107 crore in January- May 2018.
- The growth rate in FEEs in rupee terms in January- May 2019 over January- May 2018 was 2.0%.

Foreign Exchange Earnings (FEEs) from Tourism in US\$ terms

- FEEs in US\$ terms during the month of May 2019 were US\$ 1.968 billion as compared to FEEs of US\$ 1.889 billion during the month of May 2018.
- The growth rate in FEEs in US\$ terms in May 2019 over May 2018 was 4.2%.
- FEE during the period January- May 2019 were US \$ 11.814 billion as compared to US \$ 12.467 billion in January- May 2018.
- The growth rate in FEE in US\$ billion in January- May 2019 over January- May 2018 was -5.2%.
