

Foreign Exchange Earnings (in rupee and US \$ terms) through tourism in India in February, 2019

Based on the credit data of Travel Head from Balance of Payments of RBI for the previous year, Ministry of Tourism estimates monthly Foreign Exchange Earnings (FEEs) through tourism in India, both in rupee and dollar terms.

The highlights of the estimates of FEEs from tourism in India for February 2019 are as below:

Foreign Exchange Earnings (FEEs) from Tourism in Rs. Terms

- FEEs during the month of February 2019 were Rs. 17,912 crore as compared to Rs. 17,757 crore in February 2018.
- The growth rate in FEEs in rupee terms in February 2019 over February 2018 was 0.9%.
- FEEs during the period January- February 2019 were Rs. 35,991 crore as compared to Rs. 35,512 crore in January- February 2018.
- The growth rate in FEEs in rupee terms in January- February 2019 over January- February 2018 was 1.3%.

Foreign Exchange Earnings (FEEs) from Tourism in US\$ terms

- FEEs in US\$ terms during the month of February 2019 were US\$ 2.515 billion as compared to FEEs of US\$ 2.760 billion during the month of February 2018.
- The growth rate in FEEs in US\$ terms in February 2019 over February 2018 was -8.9%.
- FEE during the period January- February 2019 were US \$ 5.072 billion as compared to US \$ 5.551 billion in January- February 2018.
- The growth rate in FEE in US\$ billion in January- February 2019 over January- February 2018 was -8.6%.
