

Foreign Exchange Earnings (in rupee and US \$ terms) through tourism in India in March, 2019

Based on the credit data of Travel Head from Balance of Payments of RBI for the previous year, Ministry of Tourism estimates monthly Foreign Exchange Earnings (FEEs) through tourism in India, both in rupee and dollar terms.

The highlights of the estimates of FEEs from tourism in India for March 2019 are as below:

Foreign Exchange Earnings (FEEs) from Tourism in Rs. Terms

- FEEs during the month of March 2019 were Rs. 16,125 crore as compared to Rs. 17,222 crore in March 2018.
- The growth rate in FEEs in rupee terms in March 2019 over March 2018 was - 6.4%.
- FEEs during the period January- March 2019 were Rs. 52,116 crore as compared to Rs. 52,734 crore in January- March 2018.
- The growth rate in FEEs in rupee terms in January- March 2019 over January- March 2018 was -1.2%.

Foreign Exchange Earnings (FEEs) from Tourism in US\$ terms

- FEEs in US\$ terms during the month of March 2019 were US\$ 2.318 billion as compared to FEEs of US\$ 2.648 billion during the month of March 2018.
- The growth rate in FEEs in US\$ terms in March 2019 over March 2018 was -12.5%.
- FEE during the period January- March 2019 were US \$ 7.390 billion as compared to US \$ 8.199 billion in January- March 2018.
- The growth rate in FEE in US\$ billion in January- March 2019 over January- March 2018 was -9.9%.
