

**Foreign Exchange Earnings (in rupee and US \$ terms) through tourism
in India in October 2018**

Based on the credit data of Travel Head from Balance of Payments of RBI for the previous year, Ministry of Tourism estimates monthly Foreign Exchange Earnings (FEEs) through tourism in India, both in rupee and dollar terms.

The highlights of the estimates of FEEs from tourism in India for October 2018 are as below:

Foreign Exchange Earnings (FEEs) through tourism (in Rs. terms)

- FEEs during the month of October 2018 were Rs. 14,561 crore as compared to Rs. 14,213 crore in October 2017.
- FEEs during the period January- October 2018 were Rs. 1,58,846 crore with a growth of 11.9%, in FEE over Rs. 1,41,965 crore in January- October 2017.

Foreign Exchange Earnings (FEEs) through tourism (in US \$ terms)

- FEEs in US\$ terms during the month of October 2018 were US\$ 1.979 billion as compared to FEEs of US\$ 2.183 billion during the month of October 2017.
- FEEs during the period January- October 2018 were US\$ 23.537 billion with a growth of 8.3% in FEE over US\$ 21.743 billion in January- October 2017.
