

**Foreign Exchange Earnings (in rupee and US \$ terms) through tourism
in India in May 2018**

Based on the credit data of Travel Head from Balance of Payments of RBI for the previous year, Ministry of Tourism estimates monthly Foreign Exchange Earnings (FEEs) through tourism in India, both in rupee and dollar terms.

The highlights of the estimates of FEEs from tourism in India for May 2018 are as below:

Foreign Exchange Earnings (FEEs) through tourism (in Rs. terms)

- FEEs during the month of May 2018 were Rs. 12742 crore as compared to Rs. 12255 crore in May 2017.
- FEEs during the period January- May 2018 were Rs. 81371 crore with a growth of 12.5%, in FEE over Rs. 72334 crore in January-May 2017.

Foreign Exchange Earnings (FEEs) through tourism (in US \$ terms)

- FEEs in US\$ terms during the month of May 2018 were US\$ 1.888 billion.
- FEEs during the period January-May 2018 were US\$ 12.509 billion with a growth of 14.3% in FEE over US\$ 10.945 billion in January-May 2017.
