

Foreign Tourist Inflow to India April 2021

Ministry of Tourism compiles monthly Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs) & FTAs on e-Tourist Visa on the basis of information received from Bureau of Immigration (BOI). The following are the important highlights regarding FTAs and FTAs on e-Tourist Visa during the month of April, 2021.

Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs):

- FTAs in April, 2021 were 69442 as compared to 470 in April, 2020 registering a growth of 14674.9%. Since the year 2020 and 21 is not a normal year due to Covid Pandemic , therefore data for the month of April Shows an abnormal growth.

- FTAs during the period January- April, 2021 were 376083 as compared to 23,57,877 in January- April, 2020 registering a negative growth of -84.0%.

- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during April 2021 among the top 15 source countries was highest from USA (26.85%), followed by Bangladesh (15.65%), Afghanistan (6.92%), UK (5.87%), Nepal (4.59%) Canada (4.27%), Iraq (2.99%), Portugal (2.40%), Germany (1.42%), Russian Fed (1.41%) Maldives (1.39%), France (1.33%), Sudan (1.21%), Korea (Rep.) (1.18%), and Australia (1.02%).

- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during April 2021 among the top 15 ports was highest at Bengaluru Airport (29.96%), followed by Mumbai Airport (17.48%), Ahmedabad Airport (15.72%), Delhi Airport (9.21%), Cochin Airport (4.91%), Chennai Airport (4.04%), Hyderabad Airport (3.34%), Lucknow Airport (2.40%), Bhavnagar Seaport (2.37%), Kolkata Airport (2.11%), Calicut Airport (1.41%), Amritsar Airport (1.35%), Kakinada Seaport (1.32%), Dabolim (Goa) (0.91%), Mangalore Airport (0.72%).
