Foreign Tourist Inflow to India March 2021

Ministry of Tourism compiles monthly Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs) & FTAs on e-Tourist Visa on the basis of information received from Bureau of Immigration (BOI). The following are the important highlights regarding FTAs and FTAs on e-Tourist Visa during the month of March, 2021.

Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs):

- FTAs in March, 2021 were 123179 as compared to 306271 in March, 2020 registering a negative growth of -59.8%.
- FTAs during the period January- March, 2021 were 306641 as compared to 23, 57,407 in January- March, 2020 registering a negative growth of -87.0%.
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during March 2021 among the top 15 source countries was highest from Bangladesh (28.80%) followed by USA (22.10%), UK (6.50%), Afghanistan (6.34%), Nepal (4.34%) Canada (3.74%), Iraq (2.12%), Portugal (1.78%), Germany (1.56%), Maldives (1.27%), France (1.00%), Australia (0.86%), Italy (0.86%), Kenya (0.82%), and Russian Fed (0.80%).
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during March 2021 among the top 15 ports was highest at Delhi Airport (42.91%) followed by Haridaspur Land Check Post (18.76%), Mumbai Airport (9.43%), Chennai Airport (7.87%), Bengaluru Airport (4.85%), Hyderabad Airport (3.98%), Kolkata Airport (3.83%), Ahmedabad Airport (2.46%), Cochin Airport (2.40%), Trivandrum Airport (0.70%), Amritsar Airport (0.70%), Kakinada Seaport (0.35%), Mumbai Seaport (0.22%), Trichy Airport (0.20%) and Phulbari Land Check Post (0.15%).
