PUBLIC PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP IN PRASHAD SCHEME

1759. SHRI PRASHANTA NANDA:

Will the Minister of **TOURISM** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has followed a Public Private Partnership model in the implementation of projects under PRASHAD scheme during the last three years;
- (b) if so, the details thereof including the State of Odisha, State-wise; and
- (c) the details of achievements of projects being carried out under public private partnership model?

ANSWER

(SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)

(a) to (c): The projects under PRASHAD Scheme are 100% financed by the Government of India. However, the scheme guidelines permit convergence with other ongoing developmental activities by the Central Government, State Government, PSUs etc. The scheme provides for suitable Public Private Partnership (PPP) for improved sustainability of the projects and also for operation, maintenance and sustenance of the facilities created.
