**(a): Yes, Sir. There are several famous tourist and religious places in Madhya Pradesh and Jammu.**

**(b) to (d): The Ministry of Tourism under its scheme of ‘Swadesh Darshan’ provides funds to State Government/ Union Territory Administration/ Central Agencies, etc. for tourism infrastructure development. Under the scheme, the Ministry of Tourism has already sanctioned 4 projects in the State of Madhya Pradesh and 6 projects covering the areas of Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir & Union Territory of Ladakh.
