LEASE OUT OF HOTEL ASHOKA AND HOTEL SAMRAT

622. SHRI K.R. SURESH REDDY:

- (a) whether Government has any proposal to lease out Hotel Ashoka and the Hotel Samrat in Delhi, operated by Indian Tourism Development Corporation for 90 years, under National Monetization Pipeline;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) Government's aim to achieve out of this?

(a): The proposal is only for Asset Monetization of property of Hotel Ashok, Chankyapuri, New Delhi with a long-term sub-license/ concession period of 60 years. There is no proposal to monetise Hotel Samrat.
