DEVELOPMENT OF SRISAILAM TEMPLE UNDER PRASAD SCHEME

628. SHRI V. VIJAYASAI REDDY:

Will the Minister of **TOURISM** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether development of Srisailam Temple in Andhra Pradesh was approved in 2017-18 under PRASAD scheme and an amount of ₹48 crores was also sanctioned for this purpose by the Ministry;
- (b) if so, the details of the circuit;
- (c) when did the Ministry received proposal from the State Government of Andhra Pradesh;
- (d) what action the Ministry has taken on the above proposal;
- (e) whether Ministry sought any further clarification on the final DPR;
- (f) if so, the details of queries and response of the State Government thereon; and
- (g) by when the project is going to be completed?

ANSWER

(a) to (g): Yes, Sir. On receipt of the request from the State Government of Andhra Pradesh the project "Development of Srisailam Temple" under PRASHAD Scheme of the Ministry of Tourism was approved on 13.09.2017 at an estimated cost of ₹47.45 crore. Physical execution of the project has been completed with the final executed cost of ₹43.08 crore in the year 2021. All payments have been released by the Ministry of Tourism to the State Government of Andhra Pradesh vide sanction letter dated 28.10.2021.
