Domestic and Foreign Tourist Visits to States and UTs during 2021

Ministry of Tourism (MOT) compiles data of Domestic Tourist Visits (DTVs) and Foreign Tourist Visits (FTVs) to different States and UTs based upon the data supplied by the State Government and UT Administration.

Following are the important highlights regarding data of DTVs & FTVs during 2021.

Domestic Tourist Visits to States/UTs

- During 2021, the number of Domestic Tourist Visits to the States/UTs was 67,76,32,981 as compared to 61,02,16,157 in 2020 registering a growth of 11.05%.
- The top ten States/UT in terms of number of Domestic Tourist Visits during 2021, were Tamil Nadu (11,53,36,719), Uttar Pradesh (10,97,08,435), Andhra Pradesh (9,32,77,569), Karnataka (8,13,33,659), Maharashtra (4,35,69,238), Telengana (3,20,00,620), Punjab (2,66,40,429), Madhya Pradesh (2,55,54,067), Gujarat (2,45,25,210) and West Bengal (2,43,25,984).

Foreign Tourist Visits to States/UTs

- During 2021, the number of Foreign Tourist Visits to the States/UTs was 10,54,642 as compared to 71,71,769 in 2020 registering negative growth of 85.3%.
- The top ten States/UT in terms of number of Foreign Tourist Visits during 2021, were Punjab (3,08,135), Maharashtra (1,85,643), Delhi (1,00,178), Karnataka (72,487), Kerala (60,487), Tamil Nadu (57,622), Uttar Pradesh (44,737), Madhya Pradesh (41,601), West Bengal (34,828) and Rajasthan (34,806).
