THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

(a) & (b): The Ministry of Tourism has now revamped its Swadesh Darshan scheme as Swadesh Darshan 2.0 (SD 2.0) in order to develop sustainable and responsible tourism destinations in the country with tourist & destination centric approach. The guidelines for Swadesh Darshan 2.0 scheme has already been issued to all the States/Union Territory Administrations including Karnataka. As of now, no proposal has been received from the State Government of

(c) & (d): The Ministry of Tourism undertakes various promotional activities in the international and domestic markets to promote tourism destinations and products of the country including Karnataka in a holistic manner. These activities include promotion and marketing endeavours under 'Incredible India' brand-line, social media promotions, support to the tourism related events etc. In addition the Ministry of Tourism is also promoting Karnataka as a destination through its promotional website www.incredibleindia.org.

The Ministry of Tourism has received a project under its scheme of 'National Mission for Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive - PRASHAD' on 'Chamundeshwari Devi' (District Mysuru, Karnataka) which is one of the identified site for development under the PRASHAD scheme of the Ministry of Tourism.

The Ministry of Tourism has also sanctioned an amount for development of Railway Station at Hospet at a total cost of Rs. 5.41 crore during 2016-17.
