DEVELOPMENT OF TOURISM SECTOR IN ODISHA

- (a) details of the development of tourism sector in the State of Odisha;
- (b) performance of Odisha as a tourist destination in the country; and
- (c) steps being undertaken to further develop the tourism sector in Odisha?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): The Ministry of Tourism has provided financial assistance for the development of tourism related infrastructure under the 'Swadesh Darshan' and 'National Mission on Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD)' Schemes to the State of Odisha. In addition, Ministry of Tourism has also sanctioned project under the 'Assistance to Central Agencies for Tourism Infrastructure Development' Scheme in the State of Odisha. The details of the projects sanctioned under the above schemes in the State of Odisha is **annexed**.

The Ministry of Tourism has taken several steps over the years for the promotion & development of tourism sector in the country including the State of Odisha as per details given below:

- i. Launched 24x7 toll free Multi-Lingual Tourist Helpline.
- ii. Providing facility of e-Visa for 5 sub-categories i.e. e-Tourist visa, e-Business visa, e-Medical visa, e-Medical Attendant visa and e-Conference visa for nationals of 156 countries.
- iii. E-Visa has been further liberalized and the visa fee has been substantially reduced.
- iv. Promoting India as a holistic tourism destination including its various tourism sites and products through Incredible India Campaigns.

- v. Showcasing tourism destinations and various tourism products in different States/UTs on the www.incredibleindia.org website of the Ministry of Tourism.
- vi. Launched Incredible India Tourist Facilitator Certification Programme, a digital initiative that aims at creating an online learning platform with the objective of creating a pool of well trained professional tourist facilitators across the country to assist tourists.
- vii. Conducting Programmes under the 'Capacity Building for Service Providers' (CBSP) Scheme to train and up-grade manpower to provide better service standards.
- viii. On the recommendation of the Ministry of Tourism, 46 tourism routes have been awarded to the identified airlines by Ministry of Civil Aviation under the RCS UDAN3 Scheme. 31 of these routes have been operationalized till date.
