

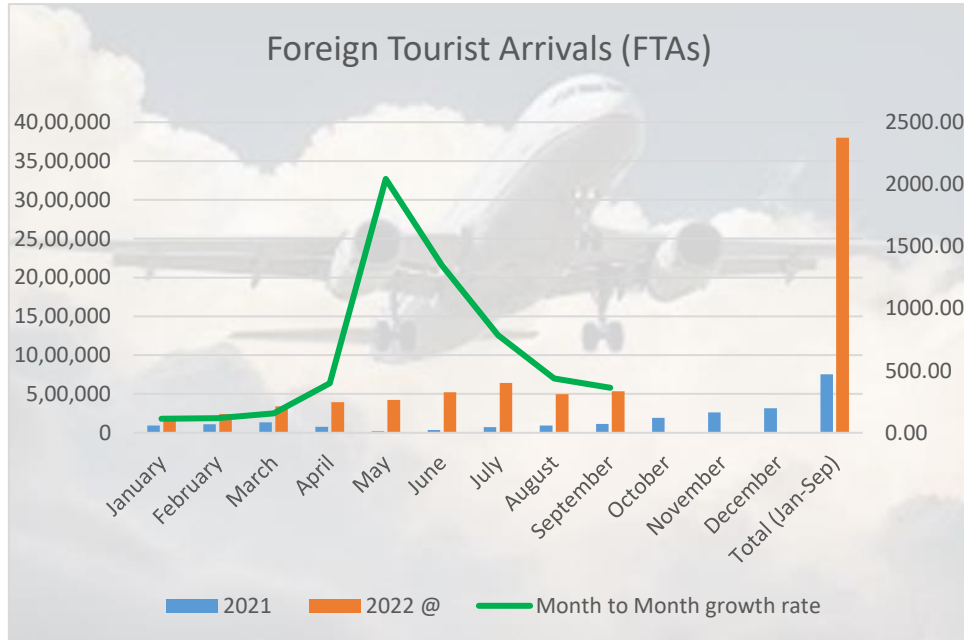
Foreign Tourist Inflow to India September, 2022

Ministry of Tourism compiles monthly Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs) on the basis of information received from Bureau of Immigration (BOI). The following are the important highlights regarding FTAs during the month of September, 2022.

Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs):

- FTAs in September, 2022 were 5,36,340 as compared to 1,15,661 in September, 2021 and 7,51,513 in September, 2019 registering a growth of 363.7% and -28.6% with respect to 2021 and 2019 respectively.
- FTAs during the period January- September, 2022 were 37,99,559 as compared to 7,54,185 in January-September, 2021 and 76,66,500 in January-September, 2019 registering a growth of 403.8% and -50.4% with respect to 2021 and 2019 respectively.
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during September, 2022 among the top 15 source countries was highest from Bangladesh (25.79%), followed by USA (15.53%), UK (7.36%), Australia (6.00%), Canada (3.63%), Malaysia (3.15%), Nepal (2.94%), Sri Lanka (2.77%), Germany (2.26%), Singapore (2.13%), France (1.76%), Russian Fed.(1.34%), Japan (1.11%), Israel (1.09%) and Vietnam (0.94%).
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during January- September, 2022 among the top 15 source countries was highest from USA (23.25%), followed by Bangladesh (20.45%), UK (10.45%), Australia (5.10%), Canada (4.33%), Sri Lanka (3.21%), Nepal (2.43%), Germany (1.86%), France (1.81%), Malaysia (1.78%), Singapore (1.78%), Maldives (1.30%), Portugal (1.23%), Oman (1.12%) & Russian Federation (0.97%).
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during September 2022 among the top 15 ports was highest at Delhi Airport (31.90%) followed by Mumbai Airport (12.58%), Haridaspur Land Check Post (11.65%), Chennai Airport (8.85%), Bengaluru Airport (5.92%), Kolkata Airport (4.02%), Cochin Airport (3.69%), Hyderabad Airport (3.45%), Ahmedabad Airport (2.37%), Ghojadanga Land Check Post (2.23%), Agartala Land Check Post (1.75%), Changrabandha Land Check Post (1.59%), Chitpur Rail Check Post (1.40%) Hilli Land Check Post (1.29%), and Tiruchirappalli Airport (1.27%).
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during January-September 2022 among the top 15 ports was highest at Delhi Airport (31.30%) followed by Mumbai Airport (13.57%), Chennai Airport (10.21%), Haridaspur Land Check Post

(9.57%), Bengaluru Airport (6.53%), Hyderabad Airport (5.20%), Cochin Airport (4.89%), Kolkata Airport (3.99%), Ahmedabad Airport (2.68%), Trivandrum Airport (1.48%), Agartala Land Check Post (1.43%), Ghojadanga Land Check Post (1.42%), Tiruchirappalli Airport (1.11%), Amritsar Airport (0.91%), and Dabolim (Goa) Airport (0.87%).
