DEVELOPMENT OF RELIGIOUS TOURIST PLACES

303. SHRI GHANSHYAM TIWARI:

Will the Minister of **TOURISM** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government proposes to make any plan for integrated development of the religious tourists places like Shekhawati Shakambhari Mata, Lohargal Dham, Jeenmata, Khatushyamji Mandir, Salasar Dham and Revasa Dham etc.;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): Under its 'Swadesh Darshan-1.0' scheme the Ministry of Tourism has sanctioned following projects including the work at **Khatushyam Ji, Sikar** and **Salasar Dham**:

- i. Integrated Development of Govind Dev ji temple (Jaipur), **Khatu Shyam Ji (Sikar)** and Nathdwara (Rajsamand) in the year 2016 at the cost of Rs.75.80 Cr.
- ii. Development of Spiritual Circuit- 'Development of **Churu (Salasar Balaji)**- Jaipur (Shri Samode Balaji, Ghatke Balaji, Bandheke Balaji)- Viratnagar (Bijak, Jainnasiya, Ambika Temple)- Bharatpur (Kaman Region) Dholpur (Muchkund) - Mehndipur Balaji Chittorgarh (Sanwaliyaji) in the year of 2017 at the cost of Rs.87.05 Cr.

In the projects, amounts of Rs.24.60 Cr. and 6.77 Cr. have been allocated for development of Tourism infrastructure at **Sikar** and **Salasar Balaji**, respectively. The approved works at Sikar have been completed and the works at Salasar Balaji are nearing completion.
