- (c) if so, whether the Ministry is considering setting up of CIHM in Andhra Pradesh considering the current CIHM has gone to Telangana after the bifurcation of the State;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

STATEMENT IN REPLY TO PART (a) TO (e) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO.*45 ANSWERED ON 06.02.2023 REGARDING SETTING UP OF CIHM IN ANDHRA PRADESH.

(a): The aims and objectives of Central Institutes of Hotel Management (CIHMs) functioning in the country is to impart hospitality education, conduct training in hospitality skills. CIHM provides instructions and training in all the crafts and skills required for the efficient functioning of Hotel and Catering establishments of all kinds, both theoretical and applied and all related organizational and management techniques.

(b): Yes, Sir.

(c) to (e):

- After the bifurcation of the united Andhra Pradesh, Ministry of Tourism, Government of India, has set-up a central Institute in hospitality at Tirupati in Andhra Pradesh in the name of Indian Culinary Institute (ICI), offering same hospitality courses as offered at Central Institutes of Hotel Management at Graduate level under National Council for Hotel Management & Catering Technology (NCHMCT) of Ministry of Tourism (MoT). This Institute also conducts Under Graduate and Post Graduate degree programs in the field of Culinary Arts.
- There is also one State Institute of Hotel Management (SIHM) at Tirupati, Andhra Pradesh set up with funding from MoT and offering hospitality courses under NCHMCT.
- Indian Institute of Tourism & Travel Management (IITTM), an Autonomous Body under MoT, has a college at Nellore, Andhra Pradesh for Tourism Education and Training.
- Further, another State Institute of Hotel Management at Kakinada has been sanctioned by Ministry of Tourism with funding support to the State Government of Andhra Pradesh for conducting hospitality courses under NCHMCT.
