- (a) the salient features of Swadesh Darshan Yojana;
- (b) the details of the funds sanctioned, allocated and utilized under the said scheme so far across the country including Rajasthan;

- (d) whether the Government has also taken initiative to promote tribal and rural tourism in the country under the said scheme;

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

(SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)

(a) to (f): The Ministry of Tourism launched its Swadesh Darshan scheme (SDS) in the year 2014-15 with the objective to develop thematic circuits in the country. As of now, the Ministry of Tourism has sanctioned 76 projects under SDS in the country including Rajasthan, the details of which along with the funds sanctioned, released and utilized is annexed. Out of the total sanctioned 76 projects, 59 projects are physically complete.

Tribal and Rural Tourism are identified themes under Swadesh Darshan scheme. The Ministry of Tourism has sanctioned 4 projects in Tribal Circuit for Rs.371.47 Crore and 2 projects in Rural Circuit for Rs.124.64 Crore in the country.

The Swadesh Darshan scheme has now been revamped by the Ministry of Tourism as Swadesh Darshan 2.0 (SD2.0) with the aim to develop sustainable and responsible tourism destinations. The Ministry is identifying destination for development in the country under SD2.0.
