(a): Ministry of Tourism promotes tourism in India, including the State of Punjab. Promotions are undertaken, inter-alia, through various initiatives, under the Central Sector Schemes of "Domestic Promotion & Publicity including Hospitality" (DPPH) and "Overseas Promotion & Publicity (OPP). The tourist destinations are also promoted through its website and social media promotions. Under the DPPH Scheme, Ministry of Tourism provides financial assistance to State Governments/Union Territory Administrations for organizing fairs/festivals for the promotion of tourism. The list of festivals in Punjab, to have received financial assistance from Ministry of Tourism, during the last five years, is given below.
