**STATEMENT IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO.245# ANSWERED ON 23.03.2023 REGARDING CAPACITY BUILDING OF TOURIST GUIDES IN UTTARAKHAND**

(a) & (b): Yes, Sir. The State-wise Domestic Tourist Visits (DTVs) & Foreign Tourist Visits (FTVs) during 2020, 2021 & 2022 are given at Annexure.

(c) & (d): The Ministry of Tourism is running Pan-India Incredible India Tourist Facilitator (IITF) Certification Program w.e.f. 01.01.2020, which is a digital initiative that aims at creating an Online learning platform with the objective of creating a pool of well trained and professional Tourist Facilitators/Guides across the country. The system provides basic, advanced Incredible India Tourist Guide (IITG) (heritage and adventure), spoken language and refresher courses for candidates. The candidates can pursue these online courses from anywhere and at any time and at their own pace. IITG (Heritage) course has been launched by Indian Institute of Tourism and Travel Management (IITTM) on 03.08.2022. Under the IITF Certification Program, candidates have to complete specialization for at least one State for completion of the course. However, more State modules can be taken up to enhance individual knowledge, which is optional.

For the purpose of increasing the capabilities of the existing guides a refresher course has been launched to integrate them in the new system of IITF/IITG. A foreign language (other than English) spoken courses for candidates are being conducted by Ministry of Tourism through IITTM. These are also applicable for guides/facilitators in the state of Uttarakhand.

In addition to this, Ministry of Tourism is conducting Linguistic Tourist Facilitator (LTF) programme which is 6-week language course in offline mode in Dutch, German, French, Japanese, Chinese etc. to create trained manpower in different foreign languages to facilitate tourist visiting India from different countries and to upgrade the skill of the existing service providers to deal effectively with foreign tourists in their own language. The following are the details in this regard:
