2.	5.7	4	Whether the internet connections to the participants should be charged on actuals.	The internet connection would be the part of overall cost.
3.	2.2	2	Whether the experience of the consortium will also be calculated with the experience of lead agency.	In case of consortium, Ministry will consider the experience of the lead agency only.
4.	2.2	2	Whether we can include FY year 2021-22 and 2022-23 for the experience 2022.	There would be no change in this regard
5.	5.8	4	Whether Mezzanine floor construction is required for the India pavilion as this will have a significant bearing on the overall cost of construction.	It was clarified that to save the cost the Mezzanine floor may not be required. Accordingly cost for Mezzanine floor may not be included
