Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the funds allocated, disbursed and spent on the PRASAD scheme since its launch;**
- (b) whether the Government has developed environment friendly transport systems under the scheme, State-wise details of the same;**
- (c) the details on the Tourism Development Centres established under the scheme; and**
- (d) the details of the Vocational Training Providers involved for hospitality and tourism education and additional training education and the measures taken by the Government for capacity and skill development under the scheme?**

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

(SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)

(a) & (c): Development of tourism is primarily the responsibility of the concerned State Government (SG)/Union Territory Administration (UTA). However, the Ministry of Tourism under its scheme viz. National Mission on Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD) provides Financial Assistance to the State Governments/Union Territory Administrations for creation of pilgrimage tourism infrastructure at the pre-identified destinations across the country. Submission of proposals and sanctioning of projects under the above scheme is a continuous process which is done in consultation with the respective SG/UTA and is subject to availability of funds, receipt of

suitable detailed project reports, adherence to scheme guidelines, performance of ongoing projects and utilization of funds released earlier etc. Based on above, a total number of 45 projects for a cost of Rs.1586.10 Lakh have been approved under the PRASHAD Scheme. Details of the projects sanctioned under the scheme is at annexure-I.

(b): Under the Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD) scheme, as part of last-mile connectivity to the destination, environment friendly transport systems are provided based on the proposals received from State Government/Union Territory Administration. State-wise details for the same is at annexure-II.

(d): No such involvement of Vocational Training Providers and measures for Capacity and Skill Development has been provided under the PRASHAD scheme. However, Ministry of Tourism has put in place the Scheme of “Capacity Building for Service Providers” (CBSP) to provide education, training and certification to the tourism service providers at every level.
