TAPPING OF TOURISM OPPORTUNITIES

5170. SHRI S. JAGATHRAKSHAKAN:

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government agrees with the view that the tourism opportunities are largely untapped;**
- (b) if so, the initiatives that are proposed to be taken by the Government keeping in view the fact that the forests, dams, rivers, lakes, and forts in the country have vast potential for various types of tourism; and**
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?**

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

(SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)

(a): As per estimation in accordance with 3rd Tourism Satellite Account (TSA) and Periodic Labor Force Survey (PLFS), 70.04 Million jobs (Direct + Indirect) are in Tourism sector during 2021-22. The contribution of tourism in total employment of the country for year 2021-22 is 12.7%.

(b) & (c): Promotion and development of Tourism is primarily undertaken by the State Governments/Union Territory Administrations. However, Ministry of Tourism, Government of India under its Schemes of Swadesh Darshan, PRASHAD and Assistance to Central Agencies, provides central financial assistance to State Governments/Union Territories/Central Agencies for development of tourism related infrastructure and facilities in the country. This is continuous process. The projects under the Schemes are identified for development in consultation with State Governments/ Union Territory (UT) Administrations and are sanctioned subject to availability of funds, submission of suitable detailed project

reports, adherence to scheme guidelines and utilization of funds released earlier. The sanctioned projects include components pertaining to tourist infrastructure at forests, dams, rivers, lakes, and forts in the country. The Swadesh Darshan scheme has now been revamped as Swadesh Darshan 2.0 (SD2.0) for development of sustainable and responsible tourist destinations.

The details of the projects sanctioned under the Swadesh Darshan, PRASHAD & Assistance to Central Agencies Schemes for the development of tourism related infrastructure in the country is given at Annexure.

In addition, Ministry also promotes India in a holistic manner through various initiatives under its Schemes of “Domestic Promotion & Publicity including Hospitality” (DPPH) and “Overseas Promotion & Publicity (OPP)”. As part of its on-going activities; it regularly releases print, electronic, online and outdoor media campaigns in the international markets, under the “Incredible India” brand-line, to promote various tourism destinations and products of India with the objective of increasing foreign tourist arrivals to the Country. The Ministry of Tourism also regularly promotes various tourism destinations and products through its website and social media promotions.

In addition, keeping in view of fact that the country has vast potential for various types of tourism, the Ministry of Tourism has taken several initiatives over the years to give boost to the tourism sector in the country, details of which are:

- i. Launched Dekho Apna Desh initiative with the objective of creating awareness among the citizens about the rich heritage and culture of the country and encourage citizens to travel within the country.**
- ii. Conducting Programmes under the ‘Capacity Building for Service Providers’ (CBSP) Scheme to train and up-grade manpower to provide better service standards.**
- iii. Launched Incredible India Tourist Facilitator Certification Programme, a digital initiative that aims at creating an online learning platform with the objective of creating a pool of well trained professional tourist facilitators across the country to support tourists.**

- iv. 24x7 toll free Multi-Lingual Tourist Helpline.**
- v. Providing facility of e-Visa for 5 sub-categories i.e. e-Tourist visa, e-Business visa, e-Medical visa, e-Medical Attendant visa and e-Conference visa for nationals of 166 countries.**
- vi. E-Visa has been further liberalized and the visa fee has been substantially reduced.**
- vii. New mountain peaks have been opened for Mountaineering/Trekking to give boost to adventure tourism in the country.**
- viii. Lowering of GST on hotels rooms with tariffs of ₹1,001 to ₹7,500/night to 12%; those above ₹7,501 to 18% to increase India's competitiveness as a tourism destination.**
- ix. On the recommendation of the Ministry of Tourism, 59 tourism routes have been awarded to the identified airlines by the Ministry of Civil Aviation under the RCS UDAN Scheme, for which Ministry of Tourism extends financial support in form of VGF (Viability Gap Funding). 51 of these routes have been operationalized till date.**
