

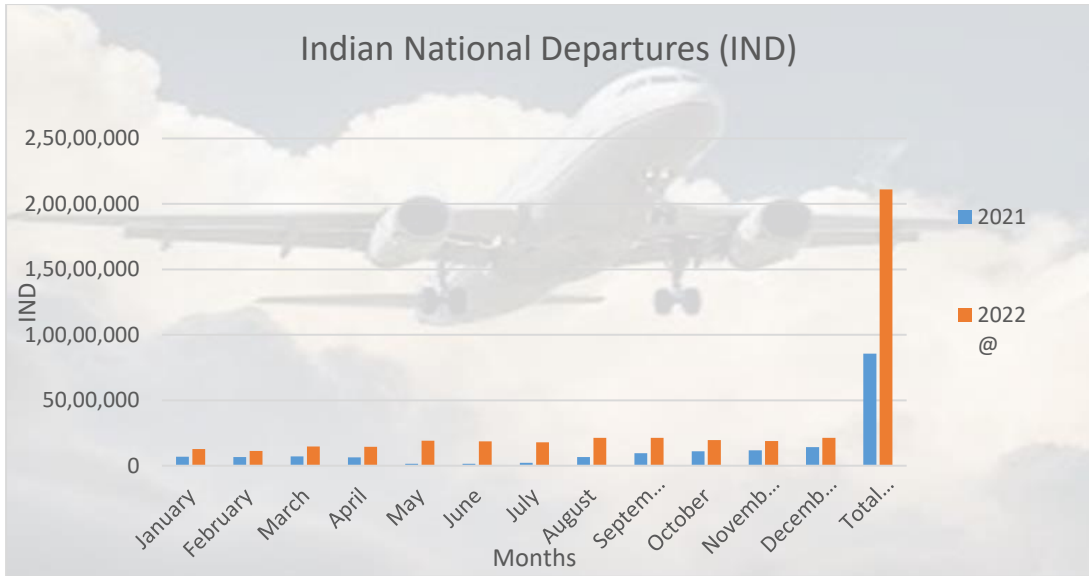
Indian National Departures December, 2022

Ministry of Tourism compiles monthly Indian National Departures (INDs) 2022 (Provisional) on the basis of information received from Bureau of Immigration (BOI).

The following are the important highlights regarding Destination wise Indian National Departures (INDs) Provisional during the month of December, 2022:

Indian Nationals Departures (INDs):

- INDs in December 2022 were 21,24,716 as compared to 14,27,843 in December 2021 and 23,55,977 in December 2019 registering a growth of 48.8 % and -9.8% with respect to 2021 and 2019 respectively.
- INDs during the period January- December, 2022 were 2,10,96,217 as compared to 85,51,315 in January-December, 2021 and 2,69,15,034 in January-December 2019 registering a growth of 146.7% and -21.6% with respect to 2021 and 2019 respectively.
- The percentage share of Destination wise Indian National Departures from India during December, 2022 among the top 15 destination countries was highest for UAE (26.81%) followed by Saudi Arabia (11.06%), USA (7.02%), Thailand (6.43%), Singapore (5.21%), Canada (4.69%), UK (3.80%), Qatar (3.50%), Oman (3.02%), Kuwait (2.97%), Bangladesh (2.57%), Australia (2.40%), Maldives (1.62%) Malaysia (1.59%), and Vietnam (1.38%).
- The percentage share of Destination wise Indian National Departures from India during January-December, 2022 among the top 15 destination countries were highest for UAE (27.93%) followed by Saudi Arabia (11.48%), USA (7.98%), Singapore (4.68%), Thailand (4.41%), UK (4.37%), Qatar (4.16%), Kuwait (3.95%), Canada (3.65%), Oman (3.42%), Australia (2.26%), Bangladesh (2.15%), Bahrain (1.57%), Malaysia (1.46%) and Maldives (1.39%).
