

MR division brings out this monthly bulletin that mainly focuses tourism statistics related to foreign tourist arrivals(FTA), Indian national departure(IND), estimation of Foreign exchange earnings(FEE) from tourism and international scenario of tourism statistics on the basis of latest available UNWTO barometer.





## **Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs)**

- FTAs in April, 2023 were 6,03,985 as compared to 3,92,930 in April, 2022 and 7,74,651 in April, 2019 registering a growth of 53.7% and -22.0% with respect to 2022 and 2019 respectively.
- FTAs during the period January- April, 2023 were 31,33,751 as compared to 11,77,680 in January-April, 2022 and 39,54,443 in January-April, 2019 registering a growth of 166.1% and -20.8% with respect to 2022 and 2019 respectively.



The percentage Share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during April'23 and Jan-April 23 among the top 5 ports








## Foreign Exchange Earnings

- FEEs during the month of April 2023 were Rs. 17,405 crore as compared to Rs. 9,611 crore in April 2022. The growth rate in FEEs in rupee terms in April 2023 over April 2022 was 81.10%.
- FEEs in US\$ terms during the month of April 2023 were US\$ 2.122 billion as compared to FEEs of US\$ 1.2621 billion during the month of April 2022. The growth rate in FEEs in US\$ terms in April 2023 over April 2022 was 68.16%.




- FEEs during the period January- April 2023 were Rs. 71,235 crore as compared to Rs. 23,584 crore in January- April 2022. The growth rate in FEEs in rupee terms in January- April 2023 over January- April 2022 was 202.04%.
- FEE during the period January- April 2023 were US \$ 8.667 billion as compared to US \$ 3.115 billion in January- April 2022. The growth rate in FEE in US\$ billion in January- April 2023 over January- April 2022 was 178.22%.




## **Indian Nationals Departures**

- INDs in April 2023 were 21,87,313 as compared to 14,45,197 in April 2022 and 22,92,018 in April 2019 registering a growth of 51.4% and -4.6% with respect to 2022 and 2019 respectively.
- INDs during the period January- April, 2023 were 84,73,542 as compared to 53,21,358 in January-April, 2022 and 87,96,682 in January-April 2019 registering a growth of 59.2% and -3.7% with respect to 2022 and 2019 respectively.



### • Gender wise % distribution






The percentage share of INDs during April'23 and Jan-April'23 among the top 5 ports
