



Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs)

- FTAs in March, 2023 were 7,95,827 as compared to 3,42,308 in March, 2022 and 9,78,236 in March, 2019 registering a growth of 132.5% and -18.6% with respect to 2022 and 2019 respectively.
- FTAs during the period January- March, 2023 were 25,29,766 as compared to 7,84,750 in January-March, 2022 and 31,79,792 in January-March, 2019 registering a growth of 222.4% and -20.4% with respect to 2022 and 2019 respectively.



The percentage Share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during March'23 and Jan-March 23 among the top 5 ports








- FEEs during the month of March 2023 were Rs. 16,903 crore as compared to Rs. 6,105 crore in March 2022. The growth rate in FEEs in rupee terms in March 2023 over March 2022 was 176.8%.
- FEEs in US\$ terms during the month of March 2023 were US\$ 2.054 billion as compared to FEEs of US\$ 0.801 billion during the month of March 2022. The growth rate in FEEs in US\$ terms in March 2023 over March 2022 was 156.58%.




- FEEs during the period January- March 2023 were Rs. 53,830 crore as compared to Rs. 13,973 crore in January- March 2022. The growth rate in FEEs in rupee terms in January- March 2023 over January- March 2022 was 285.23%.
- FEE during the period January- March 2023 were US \$ 6.545 billion as compared to US \$ 1.853 billion in January- March 2022. The growth rate in FEE in US\$ billion in January- March 2023 over January-March 2022 was 253.14%.






- INDs in March 2023 were 21,85,086 as compared to 14,67,055 in March 2022 and 22,03,115 in March 2019 registering a growth of 48.9% and -0.8% with respect to 2022 and 2019 respectively.
- INDs during the period January-March, 2023 were 62,86,229 as compared to 38,76,161 in January-March, 2022 and 65,04,664 in January-March 2019 registering a growth of 62.2% and -3.4% with respect to 2022 and 2019 respectively.



• Gender wise % distribution




The percentage share of INDs during March'23 and Jan-March'23 among the top 5 ports
