#### TOURISM POTENTIAL IN KANDI AREAS OF PUNJAB

### 145 DR. ASHOK KUMAR MITTAL:

Will the Minister of **TOURISM** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has plan to support the tourism potential in the "kandi" areas of Punjab and if so, the detail thereof;
- (b) whether Government has details on initiative to promote tourism in Punjab and "kandi" (sub-mountain) areas of Hoshiarpur district and if so, the detail thereof;
- (c) whether Government has plans for collaborations or partnerships between the Ministry and the State Government of Punjab to develop tourism infrastructure and amenities in the "kandi" areas and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) whether Government will include schemes under Ministry of Culture like PRASHAD to promote the "kandi" areas and if so, the detail thereof?

#### **ANSWER**

#### THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

(SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)

(a) to (c): Identification, development and promotion of tourist places is primarily the responsibility of the State Governments/Union Territory Administrations. However, the Ministry of Tourism has provided financial assistance under its Schemes like Swadesh Darshan, National Mission on Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD) and Assistance to Central Agencies for Tourism Infrastructure Development for the State of Punjab also in the rest of the country.

The Ministry of Tourism has now revamped its Swadesh Darshan Scheme as Swadesh Darshan 2.0 (SD2.0) with the objective to develop sustainable and responsible destinations following a tourist & destination centric approach. Under SD2.0, Amritsar and Kapurthala have been identified for development in the State of Punjab.

Further, financial assistance has also been provided to the State Government of Punjab for organizing fairs/festivals & tourism related events under Domestic Promotion & Publicity including Hospitality (DPPH) Scheme.

The details of projects sanctioned and funds allocated under the above-mentioned Schemes in the State of Punjab is given at **Annexure**.

As per procedure, proposals are received from State Governments/Union Territory Administrations from time to time for seeking financial assistance under the above schemes of the Ministry of Tourism. These proposals are examined in context of the scheme guidelines and financial assistance is extended for projects subject to fulfilment of the stipulated guidelines and availability of funds.

In addition, the Ministry of Tourism, inter-alia, promotes India as a holistic tourist destination, including Punjab. Promotions of different tourist destinations of Punjab, are also undertaken through the social media handles of Ministry of Tourism, as well as the official website: - www.incredibleindia.org.

(d): PRASHAD is a Scheme of Ministry of Tourism in which the proposals are received from the State Governments/UT Administrations on an all India basis and projects are sanctioned as per the guidelines and subject to availability of funds.
