#### MARKETING OF TOURISM IN FOREIGN COUNTRIES

#### 1739 SMT. JEBI MATHER HISHAM:

Will the Minister of **TOURISM** be pleased to state:

- (a) the amount of spending made for appropriate marketing of country's tourism in foreign countries, the details thereof over the last three years;
- (b) whether it has come to the notice of the Government that the extinction of local culture, as well as traditional environmental awareness, has negatively impacted the tourism sector, if so, what measures taken to improve the scenario; and
- (c) whether Government will provide the data on spending to maintain and renovate heritage and monuments as an integral part of Indian tourism, State/UT-wise details thereof over the last three years?

#### **ANSWER**

#### THE MINISTER FOR TOURISM

(SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)

(a) to (c): Ministry of Tourism, Government of India promotes India as a holistic destination in tourism generating markets to showcase various Indian tourism products and tourism destinations of the country to increase India's share of the global tourism market.

The Ministry of Tourism also endeavours to position India as a preferred global destination for sustainable and responsible tourism and Ministry of Tourism has formulated National Strategy for Sustainable Tourism.

The Ministry has signed a Memorandum of understanding (MoU) with the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) and Responsible Tourism Society of India (RTSOI) on 27th September 2021 on the occasion of World Tourism Day.

In order to create mass awareness Ministry in collaboration with Indian Institute of Tourism and Travel Management (IITTM) (Central Nodal Agency- Sustainable Tourism) has launched Travel for Life Pledge on MyGov.in and monthly e- newsletters are also being sent to State Governments/UT Administrations and industry stake holders.

The details of the financial assistance to various central agencies including Archaeological Survey of India for development of places of tourist interest, illumination and preservation of monuments, and to provide all facilities required by the tourists is given at Annexure.
