(a) to (c): Ministry of Tourism promotes the tourism destinations and tourism products of the country in a holistic manner. The promotions are carried out under the schemes of "Domestic Promotion and Publicity including Hospitality" (DPPH) and "Overseas Promotion & Publicity" (OPP) in the domestic and important global markets. Information on tourist destinations in the country, are also promoted through the website – www.incredibleindia.org, Dekho Apna Desh Webinars and the social media handles of the Ministry of Tourism.

The Ministry of Tourism also provides financial assistance to State Governments/Union Territory Administrations/Central Agencies under the 'Swadesh Darshan', 'National Mission on Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD)' and 'Assistance to Central Agencies for Tourism Infrastructure Development' Schemes for the development of tourism related infrastructure and facilities to provide an enriching tourism experience to the visitors.

Tourism projects creates jobs in various sectors, such as hospitality (hotels, restaurants), transportation, tour guiding, handicrafts, and more. Indirectly, tourism stimulates other businesses and services, leading to additional job opportunities.
