Domestic and Foreign Tourist Visits to States and UTs during 2022

Ministry of Tourism (MOT) compiles data of Domestic Tourist Visits (DTVs) and Foreign Tourist Visits (FTVs) to different States and UTs based upon the data supplied by the State Government and UT Administration.

Following are the important highlights regarding data of DTVs & FTVs during 2022.

Domestic Tourist Visits to States/UTs

- During 2022, the number of Domestic Tourist Visits to the States/UTs was 1731.01 Millions as compared to 677.63 Millions in 2021 and 2321.98 Millions in 2019 registering a growth of 155.45% and -25.45% with respect to 2021 and 2019 respectively.
- During 2022, the top ten States/UTs that witnessed the highest growth rate as compared to 2019 in Domestic Tourist Visits(DTVs) are Lakshadweep (227.04%), Gujarat (130.72%), Ladakh (111.43%), Rajasthan (107.44%), Chandigarh (93.58%), Assam (53.86%), Uttarakhand (45.38%), Chhattisgarh (36.59%), Mizoram (33.38%) and Jammu & Kashmir (14.45%).

Foreign Tourist Visits to States/UTs

- During 2022, the number of Foreign Tourist Visits to the States/UTs was 8.59 Millions as compared to 1.05 Millions in 2021 and 31.41 Millions in 2019 registering a 714.26 % and -72.66% with respect to 2021 and 2019 respectively.
- During 2022, the top ten States/UTs that witnessed the highest growth rate as compared to 2019 in Foreign Tourist Visits (FTVs) are Gujarat (198.39%), Mizoram (16.10%), Jharkhand (9.25%), Chandigarh (-35.56%), West Bengal (-37.38%), Madhya Pradesh (-37.66%), Andhra Pradesh (-40.84%), Ladakh (-45.00%), Nagaland (-47.59%) and Sikkim (-48.54%).
