

NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, dated ... November, 2023

G.S.R.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Ministry of Tourism, Deputy Director General/Regional Director and Assistant Director General/Director, Group 'A' Posts, Recruitment Rules, 2019, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Deputy Director General/ Regional Director and Assistant Director General/ Director in the Ministry of Tourism, namely:—

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Tourism, Deputy Director General/Regional Director and Assistant Director General/ Director (Group 'A' Posts) Recruitment Rules, 2023. (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.

2. Application.—These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Number of posts, classification and level in the pay matrix.—The number of the said posts, their classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule.

4. Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc.— The method of recruitment, age - limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.

5. Disqualification.— No person,

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax.— Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. Saving.— Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other conditions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.


Officers under the Central Government or State Government or Semi-Government or recognized research Institutions or Union territories or Universities or public sector undertakings or statutory or autonomous bodies:-

(a)(i) holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre or department; or

(ii) with five years regular service in posts in the level-9 (Rs.53,100- 1,67,800/-) or level-10 (Rs.56,100- 1,77,500/-) or equivalent in the parent cadre or department; and

Note 1: The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

Note 2: Period of deputation (including short-term contract) including period of deputation (including short-term contract) in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization or department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not to exceed four years. The maximum age-limit for appointment by deputation (including short-term contract) shall not be exceeding fifty-six years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.



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
