- (a) whether the Government has formulated any scheme to select some tourist destinations in the country on priority basis to develop them as a complete package for domestic and foreign tourists;**
- (b) if so, the details thereof;**
- (c) the details of estimated cost likely to incur under this scheme;**
- (d) the details of the expected targets likely to be set under the scheme;**
- (e) the number and details of the States likely to be covered under the scheme;**
- (f) whether the Government has decided to cover Rajasthan also under this scheme; and**
- (g) if so, the details thereof?**

**ANSWER**

**THE MINISTER OF TOURISM**

**(SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)**

**(a) to (g): The Ministry of Tourism launched its 'Swadesh Darshan Scheme' (SDS) in 2014-15 with the objective of integrated development of Theme-Based Tourist Circuits in the country and sanctioned 76 projects under various identified themes in the country including 4 projects in Rajasthan; the detail of which is at Annexure-I.**

**The Ministry of Tourism (MOT) has revamped its Swadesh Darshan scheme, as Swadesh Darshan scheme 2.0 (SD2.0), with the objective to develop sustainable and responsible tourist destinations with tourist & destination centric approach. The total budgetary outlay of Swadesh Darshan scheme applicable till March, 2026 is Rs.5000 Crore. In addition, the Ministry of Tourism has also issued guidelines for 'Challenge Based Destination Development', a sub-scheme under Swadesh Darshan 2.0. The Ministry has also notified 55 destinations across 32 States/Union Territories of India including 2 destinations in Rajasthan for development**

**under SD2.0 scheme, the list of these notified destinations is at Annexure-II.**

**Further, Ministry of Tourism under its another scheme 'Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive' (PRASHAD) also provides financial assistance to the State Governments and Union Territory Administrations for development of pilgrimage & religious destinations in the country. Under this scheme, the Ministry has sanctioned 46 projects in 26 State/UTs including 1 project in the State of Rajasthan. The detail of these projects is at Annexure-III.**
