SETTING UP OF RURAL TOURISM CLUSTERS AND PARKS IN MAHARASHTRA

182. SHRI SHRINIWAS PATIL:

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to set up rural tourism clusters and tourism parks in Maharashtra;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the details of such clusters and parks proposed to be set up in Satara & Pune Parliamentary Constituencies?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): Ministry of Tourism has formulated a "National Strategy and Roadmap for Development of Rural Tourism in India – An initiative torwards Atmanirbhar Bharat". The strategy, inter alia, lays emphasis on the need of identification of clusters of villages for rural tourism in the country including Maharashtra.

In addition, the Ministry of Tourism had identified Rural Circuit as one of the thematic circuits under its Swadesh Darshan Scheme. No project was sanctioned to the State Government of Maharashtra under Rural Circuit of the Scheme. However, the Ministry has sanctioned two projects under other circuits in the State of Maharashtra. The details of these projects are given at Annexure.
