OPENING OF TOURISM OFFICE IN KHAJURAHO

2461. SHRI VISHNU DATT SHARMA:

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Khajuraho is a UNESCO World Heritage site and has also been selected as one of the iconic tourist site, because of its historical and cultural significance;
- (b) if so, whether the Government has any proposal or plan to open a tourism office in Khajuraho, so as to coordinate developmental and management activities of tourist sites and to facilitate tourists;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

(SHRI G. KISHAN RADDY)

(a): Yes, Sir. Khajuraho Group of Monuments is a UNESCO World Heritage site. Ministry of Tourism had sanctioned a Heritage theme project in 2016-17 in Madhya Pradesh as part of its Swadesh Darshan scheme for Rs.89.82 Crore, which includes tourism development works at Khajuraho including development of a convention centre.

(b) to (d): No, Sir. Ministry of Tourism has no proposal to open a tourism office in Khajuraho and an India Tourism Office, already exists at Indore in Madhya Pradesh.
