**TOURISM PROJECTS IN MAHARASHTRA**

628. SHRI DHANANJAY BHIMRAO MAHADIK:

Will the Minister of **TOURISM** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the tourism projects approved, sanctioned and executed in the last five years in Maharashtra;
- (b) the details of funds allocated, released and utilized for the development of tourism sector in the State;
- (c) the details of employment potential created/proposed to be created due to above projects;
- (d) whether the Central Government has failed to develop tourism in Maharashtra which has huge potential and if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the corrective steps taken by Government to develop tourism in Maharashtra?

**ANSWER**

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

(SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)

(a) to (e): The Ministry of Tourism under the schemes of 'Swadesh Darshan', 'National Mission on Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD)' and 'Assistance to Central Agencies for Tourism Infrastructure Development' has provided financial assistance to State Governments/Central Agencies for the development of tourism-related infrastructure in the State of Maharashtra.

The Ministry of Tourism has revamped its Swadesh Darshan Scheme as Swadesh Darshan 2.0 (SD2.0) with the objective to develop sustainable and responsible destinations following a tourist & destination centric approach. Under SD2.0, Sindhudurg destination has been identified for development in the State of Maharashtra.

The details of sanctioned projects, amount released and amount utilized under the Swadesh Darshan 1.0, PRASHAD and Assistance to Central Agencies Schemes in the State of Maharashtra is given at **Annexure**.

No formal study has been instituted regarding the employment potential created due to the projects. However, estimated jobs due to tourism is given below:
