IMPACT OF G-20 SUMMIT ON TOURISM

(a) to (c): During India's G20 Presidency, more than 200 meetings were held at 60 locations across the country including Haryana. All these destinations have attracted global attention and put India on the global tourist map. G20 meetings have fostered global collaboration between governments, private sector and other stakeholders to provide memorable experiences for the G20 delegates visiting India.

Infrastructure has been upgraded at the host cities and various initiatives have been taken up for building the capacity of stakeholders for successful conduct of the events. Various heritage monuments in and around the host cities were also spruced up for excursion by G20 delegates and provided them with an opportunity to witness India's rich natural and cultural heritage.
