MR division is thankful to BOI and other stakeholders for providing the data and other relevant documents.



Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs)

- FTAs in November, 2023 were 9,22,265 as compared to 7,89,330 in November, 2022 and 10,92,440 in November, 2019 registering a growth of 16.8% and -15.6% with respect to 2022 and 2019 respectively.
- FTAs during the period January- November, 2023 were 81,65,945 as compared to 54,44,490 in January-November 2022 and 97,03,957 in January-November, 2019 registering a growth of 50.0% and -15.8% with respect to 2022 and 2019 respectively.






The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during November'23 and during January to November'23 among the top 5 source countries






The Purpose wise percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during Nov'23 and during Jan to November'23

Foreign Exchange Earnings


- FEEs during the month of November 2023 were Rs. 21,552 crores as compared to Rs. 15,556 crores in November 2022 and Rs. 20,372 Crore in November, 2019 registering a growth of 38.5% and 5.79% with respect to 2022 and 2019 respectively.
- FEEs in US\$ terms during the month of November 2023 were US\$ 2.587 billion as compared to FEEs of US\$ 1.902 billion during the month of November 2022 and US\$ 2.860 billion in November, 2019 registering a growth of 36.03% and -9.54% with respect to 2022 and 2019 respectively.



• FEEs during the period January- November 2023 were Rs. 2,07,220 crores as compared to Rs. 1,20,408 crores in January- November 2022 and Rs. 1,93,594 Crore in January-November, 2019 registering a growth of 72.10% and 7.04% with respect to 2022 and 2019 respectively.




• FEE during the period January- November 2023 were US \$ 25.110 billion as compared to US \$ 15.242 billion in January- November 2022 and US \$ 27.510 billion January- November 2019 registering a growth of 64.74% and -8.72% with respect to 2022 and 2019 respectively.



Indian Nationals Departures


- INDs in November 2023 were 21,94,448 as compared to 19,13,010 in November 2022 and 21,47,330 in November 2019 registering a growth of 14.7% and 2.2% with respect to 2022 and 2019 respectively.
- INDs during the period January- November, 2023 were 2,47,93,714 as compared to 1,94,47,523 in January- November, 2022 and 2,45,59,057 in January-November 2019 registering a growth of 27.5% and 1.0% with respect to 2022 and 2019 respectively.





The percentage share of Indian National Departures during November' 23 and during Jan to November 2023 among the top 5 source countries




The Purpose wise percentage share of Indian National Departures during November'23 and during Jan to November 23






• Gender wise % distribution




The percentage share of INDs during Nov'23 and Jan-Nov'23 among the top 5 ports
