

# **Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs)**

- FTAs in December, 2023 were 10,70,163 as compared to 9,92,977 in December, 2022 and 12,26,398 in December, 2019 registering a growth of 7.8% and -12.7% with respect to 2022 and 2019 respectively.
- FTAs during the period January- December, 2023 were 92,36,108 as compared to 64,37,467 in January-December 2022 and 1,09,30,355 in January-December, 2019 registering a growth of 43.5% and -15.5% with respect to 2022 and 2019 respectively.

The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during December'2023 and during January to December'2023 among the top 5 source countries




The Purpose wise percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during December'2023 and during Jan to December'2023





The percentage Share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during December'2023 and Jan-December'2023 among the top 5 ports




# **Foreign Exchange Earnings**

- FEEs during the month of December 2023 were Rs. 24,707 crores as compared to Rs. 19,527 crores in December 2022 and Rs. 22,873 Crore in December, 2019 registering a growth of 26.53% and 8.02% with respect to 2022 and 2019 respectively.
- FEEs in US\$ terms during the month of December 2023 were US\$ 2.967 billion as compared to FEEs of US\$ 2.369 billion during the month of December 2022 and US\$ 3.211 billion in December, 2019 registering a growth of 25.25% and -7.60% with respect to 2022 and 2019 respectively.



- FEEs during the period January- December 2023 were Rs. 2,31,927 crores as compared to Rs. 1,39,935 crores in January- December 2022 and Rs. 2,16,467 Crore in January-December, 2019 registering a growth of 65.74% and 7.14% with respect to 2022 and 2019 respectively.
- FEE during the period January- December 2023 were US \$ 28.077 billion as compared to US \$ 17.611 billion in January- December 2022 and US \$ 30.721 billion January- December 2019 registering a growth of 59.43% and -8.61% with respect to 2022 and 2019 respectively.




# **Indian Nationals Departures**


- INDs in December 2023 were 24,80,082 as compared to 21,55,211 in December 2022 and 23,55,977 in December 2019 registering a growth of 15.1% and 5.3% with respect to 2022 and 2019 respectively.
- INDs during the period January- December, 2023 were 2,72,73,796 as compared to 2,16,02,734 in January- December, 2022 and 2,69,15,034 in January-December 2019 registering a growth of 26.25% and 1.33% with respect to 2022 and 2019 respectively.

The Purpose wise percentage share of Indian National Departures during December'23 and during Jan to December 23






• Gender wise % distribution
