Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs)

- FTAs in April, 2024 were 6,50,748 as compared to 6,03,985 in April, 2023 and 7,74,651 in April, 2019 registering a growth of 7.7% and -16.0% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.
- FTAs during the period January- April, 2024 were 34,71,833 as compared to 31,33,751 in January-April 2023 and 39,54,443 in January-April, 2019 registering a growth of 10.8% and -12.2% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.






Percentage Share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during April 2024 and during January to April 2024 among the top 5 source countries




Purpose wise percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during April 2024 and during January to April 2024







Percentage Share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during April 2024 and January-April 2024 among the top 5 ports




Foreign Exchange Earnings

- FEEs during the month of April 2024 were Rs. 17,909 crores as compared to Rs. 17,405 crores in April 2023 and Rs. 17,693 Crore in April, 2019 registering a growth of 2.90% and 1.22% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.
- FEEs in US\$ terms during the month of April 2024 were US\$ 2.147 billion as compared to FEEs of US\$ 2.122 billion during the month of April 2023 and US\$ 2.544 billion in April, 2019 registering a growth of 1.20% and -15.59% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.




• FEEs during the period January-April 2024 were Rs. 90,600 crores as compared to Rs. 71,235 crores in January-April 2023 and Rs. 71,132 Crore in January-April, 2019 registering a growth of 27.18% and 27.37% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.

• FEE during the period January- April 2024 were US \$ 10.901 billion as compared to US \$ 8.667 billion in January- April 2023 and US \$ 10.128 billion January- April 2019 registering a growth of 25.78% and 7.63% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.




Indian Nationals Departures

- INDs in April 2024 were 25,27,697 as compared to 21,87,313 in April 2023 and 22,92,018 in April 2019 registering a growth of 15.56% and 10.28% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.
- INDs during the period January- April, 2024 were 97,37,681 as compared to 84,73,542 in January- April, 2023 and 87,96,682 in January-April 2019 registering a growth of 14.92% and 10.70% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.






Percentage Share of Indian National Departures during April 2024 and during January to April 2024 among the top 5 source countries




Purpose wise percentage share of Indian National Departures during April 2024 and during January to April 2024






• Gender wise % distribution




Percentage Share of INDs during April 2024 and January-April 2024 among the top 5 ports
