

Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs)

- FTAs in March, 2024 were 8,59,688 as compared to 7,95,827 in March, 2023 and 9,78,236 in March, 2019 registering a growth of 8.0% and -12.1% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.
- FTAs during the period January- March, 2024 were 28,21,085 as compared to 25,29,766 in January-March 2023 and 31,79,792 in January-March, 2019 registering a growth of 11.5% and -11.3% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.



Percentage Share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during March 2024 and during January to March 2024 among the top 5 source countries




Purpose wise percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during March 2024 and during January to March 2024







Percentage Share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during March 2024 and January-March 2024 among the top 5 ports




Foreign Exchange Earnings

• FEEs during the month of March 2024 were Rs. 22,761 crores as compared to Rs. 16,903 crores in March 2023 and Rs. 16,440 Crore in March, 2019 registering a growth of 34.66% and 38.45% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.

FEEs in US\$ terms during the month of March 2024 were US\$ 2.741 billion as compared to FEEs of US\$ 2.054 billion during the month of March 2023 and US\$ 2.333 billion in March, 2019 registering a growth of 33.42% and 17.49% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively



- - FEEs during the period January- March 2024 were Rs. 72,691 crores as compared to Rs. 53,830 crores in January-March 2023 and Rs. 53,439 Crore in January-March, 2019 registering a growth of 35.04% and 36.03% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.
 - FEE during the period January- March 2024 were US \$ 8.754 billion as compared to US \$ 6.545 billion in January- March 2023 and US \$ 7.584 billion January- March 2019 registering a growth of 33.74% and 15.42% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.






Indian Nationals Departures

- INDs in March 2024 were 24,08,533 as compared to 21,85,086 in March 2023 and 22,03,115 in March 2019 registering a growth of 10.23% and 9.32 with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.
- INDs during the period January- March, 2024 were 72,09,984 as compared to 62,86,229 in January- March, 2023 and 65,04,664 in January-March 2019 registering a growth of 14.69% and 10.84% with respect to 2023 and 2019 respectively.



Purpose wise percentage share of Indian National Departures during March 2024 and during January to March 2024




• Gender wise % distribution






Percentage Share of INDs during March 2024 and January-March 2024 among the top 5 ports
